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DAY 03 - Jul.23rd: PITUSIRAY & SAWASIRAY - WACHUMA CEREMONY



The Pitusiray Mountain is located in the province and district of Calca in the department of Cusco. We will set out from the Sacred Valley, making our way to Calca. From there, we'll continue to Huaran, where the trail will lead us uphill for approximately one hour until we reach Pitusiray and Sawasiray, all while taking in the breathtaking backdrop of this beautiful place.

Today, we will also have our first opportunity to work with San Pedro (Wachuma), a powerful and sacred - yet gentle - "teacher and healer" plant traditionally

used to heal the heart in times of deep pain and emotional hurt. Working with this medicine as part of a sacred ceremony, and with the protection of ancestral spirits, allows us to reconnect with the ancestral energy that helps us heal and transform our lives for the better under the guidance.

In the afternoon we return to your hotel in Sacred Valley.

DAY 04 - Jul.24th: QUILLARUMIYOQ & WACHUMA



After breakfast, we will leave Cusco and journey through the expansive Anta Valley, a beautiful agricultural region dotted with charming adobe villages, golden fields of grain, and grazing cattle. As we leave the main road, we will arrive at the Incan archaeological site of Quillarumiyoc, known as the Temple of the Moon. This sacred site holds a deep spiritual significance, featuring ancient walls, fountains, and the mesmerizing Moonstone—a unique limestone boulder intricately carved with a bas-relief of the moon.

Here, we will walk along well-preserved Inca trails, immersing ourselves in the wisdom of the past. Exploring the Quillarumiyoc caves,

we will witness the Incas' remarkable carvings that reflect their profound spiritual knowledge. We will then visit the temple of the Quillarumiyoc water priest, a stunning example of imperial Inca

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architecture. At its heart lies a serene mini-waterfall, where we will take a moment for cleansing and purification, allowing the mind to relax and connect with the energy of the site.

Shaped like a crescent moon, the Temple of the Moon embodies the essence of feminine energy and

celestial alignment. Its design reflects the sacred Inca trilogy and is perfectly oriented to capture the morning sunlight, serving as both an astronomical and spiritual calendar.

Today, we also have another opportunity to work with San Pedro (Wachuma). We continue to Chinchero in the afternoon.

DAY 05 - Jul.25th: ANDEAN COSMOVISION AND TRADITIONAL ANDEAN HEALING ARTS

Today, feeling refreshed after a relaxing night at our hotel, we continue our energy work with ceremonies and healing rituals. Our team will discuss Andean Cosmovision and traditional Andean Healing Arts, guiding us through rituals of welcoming and reconnecting with the ancestral spirits of the Andes.

This full day of energy work will allow us to feel fully immersed in ancestral traditions and deepen our connection to our inner self as well as the land we are visiting. We will also learn



about the concepts of Nogan Kani and Ayni, the latter being a fundamental aspect of Andean Cosmovision that allows us to better understand the unique reciprocal relationship the Andean peoples have with the earth. By understanding that love is always a reciprocal relationship (love for people, nature, the planet), we can reassess our relationships and how we treat ourselves and the world around us.

In the evening, you will have an opportunity to participate in an Ayahuasca Ceremony.

DAY 07- Jul.27th: ENJOYING RAINBOW MOUNTAIN (VINIKUNKA) AND PACCHANTA



After breakfast, we set out from the Sacred Valley, beginning a truly stunning three-hour adventure in our own private transport to the very small village of Pacchanta (3,800m / 12,464ft). Throughout our adventure, we pause so that we can visit the aweinspiring Vinicunca, that Rainbow Mountain, a natural wonder well-known for all of its energetic, mineral-rich layers which paint the landscape in such stunning hues.

As we continue our drive, we pass through several picturesque Andean villages such as Urcos, Cattca, and

Ocangate, each offering glimpses into customary highland life. The road itself is certainly a magnificent introduction to the overwhelming grandeur of the Cordillera Vilcanota. Furthermore, it has countless spectacular views of Ausangate, the region's highest and most revered peak.

Upon arriving in Pacchanta (4,400 meters / 14,432 feet), we take time for unwinding in the natural hot springs, where the warm, mineral-rich waters offer a moment of peace as well as rejuvenation. We are enveloped by stunning Ausangate vistas at the valley's border, basking in the mountains' quiet, letting this holy land's power imbue us with a deep feeling of peace and unity.

DAY 08 - Jul. 28th: SACRED JOURNEY TO THE AUSANGATE LAGOONS

We commence our day with a special breakfast, preparing ourselves for the special adventure ahead to the lagoons of Apu Ausangate. As we initially set out, we connect ourselves to the ancient paths of our very own ancestors. We are further accompanied by the ever-present spirit of Mama Coca, a vital symbol of wisdom and deep reverence.



Our adventure takes us up to the Apacheta, a sacred pass between mountains and/or valleys. We now present our sincere offerings to the Apus (mountain spirits) and Mamacocha (water spirits), requesting their blessings as we enter their sacred domain. All together, we now share all of the sacred coca leaves, deepening our connection to the land and also its energies.

From the Apacheta, we descend downwards toward those sacred

lagoons of Otorongo Cocha as

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well as Ancash Cocha. In those locations, the waters invite all of us for the purpose of purifying both body and also spirit. As we deeply immerse ourselves within these tranquil waters, we align ourselves with the very crystal clarity that the snow-covered peaks of Apu Ausangate have, deeply feeling a renewal and transformation within.

Returning back into the community of Pacchanta, a nourishing lunch awaits for us. Afterward, we can admire the exquisite local textile craftsmanship, a declaration to the undergoing traditions of the Andean people, bringing our sacred adventure to a harmonious close.

DAY 09 - Jul. 29th: FAREWELL TO APU AUSANGATE

After breakfast, we proceed onward to Lucio's Temple, a holy shrine where we will extend our last thanks and say goodbye to Master Ausangate. In this quite deep moment, we surely honor the connection we have forged with the mountains. We honor, too, the waters and the ancient energies that have guided our adventure.

After a nourishing lunch, we begin our return to Cusco, carrying with us the wisdom, clarity, as well as renewal gifted by this sacred land.

DAY 10 - Jul.30th: EXPLORE CUSCO

After breakfast, we begin our travels at Sacsayhuamán, a construction marvel filled with mystery and legend. While walking in the middle of its huge stone facades, we will find the engaging past and elaborate building methods which still foster wonder.



Next, we enter a place of deep transformation, as well as then we subsequently guide you through a rebirth process in a sacred cave of the Cosmic Mother. This cave is universally known also as the Womb of Mother Earth—a space that allows universally for renewal and connection. Our overall path subsequently leads nearly all of us toward Tambomachay, a very serene retreat favored highly by the Incas, often suitably called then "Baños del Inca" or "Baños de la Ñusta" (Baths of those Incas or Baths of that Princess). Once a place for ritual purification, this holy site is thought

to be a temple for water worship.

We shall participate in one special Andean Initiation Ceremony at the Temple of the Condor, a deep event linking us to the knowledge of ancestral lines. We do indeed pay tribute to that holy Incan triad—Puma, Serpent, and Condor—and then study that old faith in alternate realities. Following our visits onto various temples set in mountains nearby, we go back toward Cusco, where we soak up the

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city's bright feel and the kindness of its people.

Subsequently, we visit Coricancha, which is deemed as one of the most revered temples within the Incan Empire, being dedicated toward the Sun God. Once adorned along the walls as well as across floors covered entirely in sheets of solid gold, this sacred site was a complete declaration to Incan devotion. As we carefully wander through its particular courtyard, formerly filled with many golden statues, we reflect back on the very grandeur as well as spiritual depth of this extraordinary place.
